Comprehensive Placement Training

Final-year students underwent 30 hours of structured training in Jan 2026, in employability skills, including communication, adaptability, creativity, critical thinking, collaboration, workplace ethics, and socio-emotional development. Training also included interview preparation and exposure to AI and digital tools.

Industry-Supported Skill Development Programmes

- **TNS India Foundation:** 30-day (100-hour) training in BFSI and Front Office Operations with certification and placement support (50 students)
- **Capgemini CSR through EduBridge:** 100-hour BFSI training for 180 students combining theory and practical exposure
