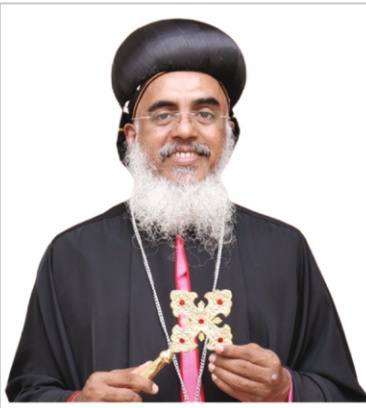

OUR HISTORY

The Malankara Orthodox Syrian Church founded by the Apostle St. Thomas in A.D 52 is one of the oldest Churches with a rich legacy and tradition. His Holiness Moran Mar Baselios Marthoma Paulose II, Malankara Metropolitan and Catholicos of the East is the successor to this throne of St. Thomas and the head of the Malankara Orthodox Church. St. Thomas Orthodox Cathedral, Broadway is the first parish established outside the Kerala diocese and is considered to be the mother of all parishes. To have a parish of their own on this sacred soil is a great achievement for Orthodox Christians. This parish was originally built by the British government as a garrison for British soldiers and with the permission of the Anglican Bishop, the members started to share this church and the first Holy Eucharist was started in 1960. The first congregation consisted of 16 members. In the year 2016 this Cathedral has celebrated its centenary. From a 16 member congregation this cathedral has grown tremendously into a big parish with three chapels. Presently there are more than 11 independent parishes in Chennai and almost all parishes can trace their origin to St. Thomas Orthodox Cathedral. It was a deep desire of the members of St. Thomas Orthodox Cathedral to start an education institution to enlighten the society and St. Thomas Matriculation Higher Secondary School in Broadway was established in 1958 under St. Thomas Syrian Cathedral Education and Charitable Trust. After serving the society through this school, it was decided to start a college for Arts & Science.

The St. Thomas College of Arts and Science was established in 1999 as a co-educational institution which is governed by the St. Thomas Orthodox Syrian Cathedral Parish Trust of St. Thomas Orthodox Cathedral, Broadway. The Patron of our college is His Holiness Baselios Marthoma Mathews - III, Catholicos of the East and Malankara Metropolitan. The present chairman is His Grace Geevarghese Mar Philaxenos - Metropolitan of the Diocese of Madras of the Malankara Orthodox Syrian Church. The college is governed by its board of trustees and administrated by its executive headed by His Grace Geevarghese Mar Philaxenos, Chairman.

THE CAMPUS

Easily accessible from all parts of Chennai, the college is situated in Koyambedu by the intersection of the two major arterial roads of the city, the Inner Ring Road (100ft Road) and Poonamalle High Road, and very near the CMBT bus station and Koyambedu Metro Rail Station. Despite being in the heart of the city, the serene campus is far separated from its hustle and bustle, and offers an ideal surrounding for intellectual pursuits.

INFRASTRUCTURE

St Thomas College has excellent facilities like Library, Computer Labs, Video Production Lab, Photography Studio, Multimedia Lab, Film Editing Lab and Audio Lab which is constantly maintained and updated to ensure that the study at the college is supported using state of the art technology and equipment.

ACADEMIC ENVIRONMENT

The faculty of the college consists of qualified and committed teachers headed by the Principal Dr. K. Florence. All staff members are encouraged to continually improve the teaching methods through audio-visual aids, self-study and group discussions and group assignments. Every teacher (referred as tutor) is assigned about 25 students to mentor and monitor their academic performance. A notable aspect of the academic life at the college is the opportunities that are created for students to learn from domain experts who are invited as guest lecturers, either during regular class hours or during departmental association meetings, and through fellow students who visit the campus from different parts of the world.





EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Students are encouraged to participate in departmental, intra-mural and inter-collegiate sports meets, academic competitions, talent festivals and cultural meets. Every year in October the College hosts the much popular Thomfest inter-collegiate cultural competitions & Thom Talenzia, inter departmental competition. The college supports the activities of the National Service Scheme (NSS), National Cadet Corps (NCC), Youth Red Cross Society, Red Ribbon Club, Green Club, Citizen Consumer Club, Women Empowerment Cell, Antidrug Club, ED Cell, Institutional Innovation Council, Friends of Police (FOP), College Choir and the Alumni Association.

CAREER GUIDANCE & PLACEMENT CELL

All prospective candidates are required to fill and submit the Application forms through our college website www.saintthomascollege.com on payment. Manual forms are also available at the college office. Applications are to be submitted within seven days after the publication of results by TN. Govt. Information regarding provisionally selected applicants for all programmes will be sent by e-mail. No information will be sent to applicants who have not been selected for the programmes applied.

Selected applicants must pay the prescribed fees and submit original and two attested photocopies of the following documents:

1. STD X and STD XII Statement of Marks
2. Transfer Certificate and Conduct Certificate from the previous institution
3. Photocopy of the Community Certificate

5. Certificate of proof for the differently abled/for those applying in the NCC/Sports quota and for wards of ex-servicemen.
6. Baptism Certificate and letter from Parish Priest for Orthodox Syrian applicants.
7. Blood Group Certificate.
8. Copy of Aadhar Card of Applicant and Parent.

The admission of candidates to their chosen course will be made on the basis the rules of the University of Madras and the Government of Tamil Nadu and other norms laid down by the College from time to time. All admissions are provisional and subject to the approval of the University.

Parents and guardians are informed that the College does not accept donations / capitation fees for admission directly or indirectly. Any malpractice in this regard may be brought to the notice of the Principal immediately.

ATTENDANCE

As per the rules of the University of Madras, every student must put in a minimum of seventy-five percentage of attendance before he or she is permitted by the college to appear for the University Examinations. However, it is recommended that the students put in 100% attendance for all the lecture classes and practicals in their own interest and for their benefit. Marks for regular attendance forms a component of Internal Assessment.

DISCIPLINE

- (a) Tobacco in any form, alcohol and drugs is strictly forbidden in the college and any student violating this rule will be expelled from the college.
- (b) Ragging in any form is a serious offence and those indulging in it will be summarily dismissed and a police complaint will be registered.
- (c) The use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited within the college premises.
- (d) Dress code must be observed.

In all disciplinary matters the decision of the College authorities shall be final.

FEES

Tuition and special fees prescribed by the college must be paid before the 30th June & 30th November for each term respectively. Delayed payments will be subject to levy of fines. Excessive delays will entail removal of name from the college rolls and denial of attendance.

Fees once paid by the student will not be refunded under any circumstances.

Discontinuance in the middle of the course or removal from rolls for any reason will entail forfeiture of course fees for the whole duration of the course.

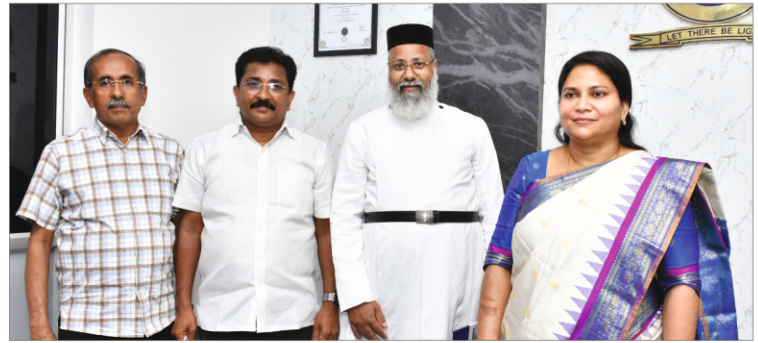
GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS
